All you need is love

'Love? Above all things I believe in love. Love is like oxygen. Love is a manysplendoured thing. Love lifts us up where we belong. All you need is love.' In an attempt to express the depth of his love, the character Christian from the film Moulin Rouge pulls together the lyrics of some of the most famous love songs of recent decades. Since time began, poetry, prose, and song have attempted to put into words the great mystery that is love. 'At the touch of love, everyone becomes a poet,' the philosopher Plato put it.

Today's Gospel offers one of the most eloquent passages on love in the Gospels. It reveals the vision of Jesus for his followers and explains how we should treat one another. We are to love each other with the same love Jesus showed during his time on earth, that great and generous love that culminated in his 'laying down his life for his friends'. It is in the way we love one another, the way we understand and forgive and support one another, that we experience the life and love of Jesus.

There are more than 20 references to love in today's readings. In the second reading we hear that 'everyone who loves is begotten by God and knows God'. That love that

God showed by sending his Son for us, is the same generous, wholehearted, selfsacrificing love we are called to show others - all others. God does not have favourites. We find it so hard to accept the revelation that it is God's delight to be worshipped in the way we touch and look at each other, in the way we listen and talk to each other, in the way we forgive and promise to start all over again.' Church re-opening

Thankfully, our Church doors will be open to the public for daily and week end Mass from Monday according to the usual schedule, which is laid out on the Parish Information list on the back page of this Newsletter.

The rules which were in place before the lockdown will continue. In the outer churches there will be a limit of 50 people with social distancing in place. In Ferns Church we will be able to have 50 people in each pod, which will be the two sides and centre, so the maximum will be 150 people. The three distinct areas will use their own entrances and exits. For the side isles, entrance will be from the car park side and exit from the Enniscorthy Road side. The Main Entrance will be, entrance for Enniscorthy end and exit from Main St. side. There is no movement to be made from one pod to another. Please observe the seat and floor markings to help keep everyone safe,

Mass in the Convent Chapel will take place each Wednesday evening at 7.00p.m. as before the lockdown.

Face Masks must be worn at all times in Church/Chapel, Sanitise your hands on entering and exiting the Church. Please take every precaution to keep yourself and others safe.
