Receive Forgiveness; Show Mercy

The logic of the kingdom of heaven is clear: when we receive forgiveness, we show mercy. When we don't know forgiveness; we can't show mercy and our hearts grow hard. We seek forgiveness for we have sinned; we show mercy because we have been forgiven. When did you last experience the grace of the Sacrament of Mercy, the Sacrament of Forgiveness?

In the Sacrament of Reconciliation God's mercy and forgiveness is made real and present-through it we are touched by his forgiving and merciful heart.

John 8:31-42

'Then you will know the truth and the truth will set you free'

'It is easy to love people who are far away' said St. Mother Teresa. 'It is not always easy to love those close to us. It is easier to give a cup of rice to relieve hunger that to forgive someone in our own home.' Forgiveness is another word for love. Replacing the word 'forgiveness' for 'love' in St Paul's great hymn of love (1 Corinthians 13) gives us an insight into how wonderful forgiveness truly is: 'Forgiveness is patient and kind; forgiveness does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful. It does not rejoice in wrong doing but rejoices with the truth. Forgiveness bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things' (cfl Corinthians 13:4-7).
