The Parish Programme "Grow in Love" is up and running in preparation for First Penance and First Communion, something we could not do for two years. With Live Streaming people are able to avail of Mass and other services from the parish church, if afraid or unable to come to the Church. I am most grateful to Fr. Pat Stafford for his invaluable help and support, he is a great blessing to me and the parish.

Grateful thanks is extended to all involved in various ministries in the parish. Your generosity and support is something I greatly value and appreciate.
